**SUBJECT:** IdenTrust Digital Certificate Price Increase – *Certification Authority and Public Key Infrastructure Services* - DIS Master Contract # T09-MST-181

Beginning January 1, 2010, a new fee structure will be effective for digital certificates purchased through the optional-use Master Contract for Certification Authority and Public Key Infrastructure Services (Master Contract #T09-MST-181).

This new fee structure applies to both the initial purchase and renewal of Digital Certificates. Changes to the Digital Certificate fee structure are as follows:

Certificate Type	Current Pricing	Pricing effective January 1, 2010
<b>HIGH ASSURANCE *</b> – Signing & Encryption	\$70	\$75
<b>HIGH ASSURANCE *</b> – Signing Only	\$64	\$69
<b>INTERMEDIATE ASSURANCE *</b> – Signing & Encryption	\$50	\$55
<b>INTERMEDIATE ASSURANCE *</b> – Signing Only	\$44	\$49
<b>STANDARD ASSURANCE</b> – Roaming or Browser	\$20	\$25

\* Requires use of Cryptographic USB Token or Smartcard and Smartcard reader; pricing for this hardware, which may be required for the initial purchase of a Digital Certificate, is not included in the price of the certificate.
